



SCRAP SERIES – OFFICIAL FIGHTER RULESET

Please read carefully. Entry into Scrap Series confirms your acceptance of all rules and conditions below.

1. FORMAT OVERVIEW

- Scrap Series is a **knockout tournament**.
- Each bout consists of **one (1) round only**.
- Round duration: **60 seconds**.
- **The winner advances**, the loser is eliminated.
- Fighters may compete in **multiple bouts on the same night**, up to a maximum of **four (4)**.

This format is designed for **fast-paced, high-intensity action**. Fighters must be prepared to compete with minimal rest.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- Scrap Series is open to any eligible participant who has been accepted by the organisers.
- Fighters enter and compete **entirely at their own risk**.
- All registration requirements must be completed prior to competing.
- Medical clearance and proof of fitness **may be required**.
- **A minimum ticket sales requirement applies to guarantee entry on the night**.
- Each fighter must sell a **minimum of twenty-five (25) physical tickets** to secure their place on the bout card.
- Failure to meet the minimum ticket requirement may result in **removal from the event**, without refund or compensation.
- Scrap Series reserves the right to **refuse, revoke, reallocate or withdraw entry** at its sole discretion.

3. WEIGHT & MATCHMAKING



- Scrap Series matchups are based **solely on weight**.
- Fighters will be matched within a **5kg weight allowance**.
- **There are no considerations for age, experience, record or background.**
- All matchups are made **on the night of the event**.
- Fighters are drawn **completely at random**, using a blind draw system.
- Once drawn, matchups **cannot be changed**.

The organiser's decision on weight eligibility and matchmaking is **final**.

4. PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND & SUPER SCRAP SERIES

- Scrap Series is primarily designed for **non-professional and recreational fighters**.
- While age, experience, record or background are not considered during Scrap Series matchmaking, **fighter safety and competitive balance remain a priority**.

Professional Background

Fighters with a current or former **professional combat sports background** may be identified at any stage.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Professional Boxing
- Professional MMA
- Professional Muay Thai
- Professional Kickboxing
- Any recognised professional combat sport

Super Scrap Series

- Fighters with professional backgrounds **may be removed from Scrap Series** at the organiser's discretion.
- These fighters may instead be entered into **Super Scrap Series**, a separate competition tailored specifically for:
 - Current professional fighters
 - Former professional fighters
 - High-level competitive athletes

Super Scrap Series operates under its own ruleset, structure and prize details, which will be communicated separately.



- Entry into the Super Scrap Series is **not guaranteed**.
- No refunds, compensation or appeals apply if a fighter is reclassified.

All classification decisions are **final**.

5. EQUIPMENT & ATTIRE

- Approved 10oz gloves and safety equipment will be supplied or specified by Scrap Series.
- Fighters must wear appropriate attire including mouth guard, shorts and boxing boots.
- No unauthorised equipment, jewellery or accessories are permitted.
- Failure to comply may result in disqualification.

6. CORNERS & WHIPS

- Fighters may have **one (1) whip / corner assistant**.
- Corners may only enter the competition area when instructed.
- Coaching during the round may be limited due to the short format.
- Interference or misconduct may result in warnings or disqualification.

7. LEGAL TECHNIQUES

- Legal techniques will be clearly outlined during the official rules briefing.
- Dangerous, illegal or unsportsmanlike conduct is strictly prohibited.
- Any breach of the rules may result in immediate disqualification.

8. STOPPAGES & SAFETY

A bout may be stopped at any time by:

- The referee
- Medical staff
- Event officials

Reasons for stoppage include:

- Knockdowns or inability to intelligently defend
- Injury
- Safety concerns



- Referee discretion

Referee/Judges and medical decisions are **final and not subject to appeal**.

9. SCORING & DECISIONS

- There are **three official judges**
- Victory is determined by:
 - Referee stoppage
 - Medical stoppage
 - Clear judges decision at the end of the 60 seconds

If required, the judges will determine the winner based on:

- Effective aggression
- Control
- Ring dominance

10. TOURNAMENT PROGRESSION

- Winners advance immediately to the next round.
- Rest periods are minimal and determined by the event schedule.
- Fighters must remain available throughout the event until eliminated or crowned champion.

11. PRIZE MONEY & COMMISSIONS

- The tournament winner receives the advertised **winner-takes-all prize**.
- Ticket and PPV commissions (where applicable) will be paid as agreed and via bank transfer as soon as the competition has ended.
- Failure to comply with rules may result in forfeiture of prize money or commissions.

12. MEDIA, FILMING & PROMOTION

- All Scrap Series events are professionally filmed and broadcast.
- By entering, fighters grant Scrap Series the right to:
 - Film, photograph and record bouts
 - Use footage and imagery for promotion, marketing and media
 - Distribute content across all platforms



No additional compensation is payable for media usage.

13. CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE

- Fighters must behave professionally at all times.
- Abuse, intimidation or violence outside the bout will not be tolerated.
- Scrap Series reserves the right to remove fighters from the event and future competitions.

14. DISCLAIMER & ASSUMPTION OF RISK

Combat sports carry inherent risks.

By entering Scrap Series, fighters:

- Acknowledge and accept all risks involved
- Confirm they are physically fit to compete
- Agree Scrap Series, its partners, venues and staff are not liable for injury, loss or damage

15. FINAL AUTHORITY

- Scrap Series reserves the right to:
 - Amend or interpret these rules at any time
 - Make final decisions in the interest of safety and event integrity

All decisions made by Scrap Series officials are **final**.
